

# SATURDAY LESSON SCHEDULE - PARENTS' JUGGLING GUIDE



We understand that trying to schedule lessons for more than one child can be daunting. We hope this "**juggling guide**" will help you find the appropriate class for each child at similar times.

The grid below shows the starting dates for each class level and time period combination. So if you find the class level and time period you want, you can see when a class will be starting.

We arrange our schedule a little bit differently - we don't have all our classes start and end on the same Saturday - so that we can better respond to your needs. This approach allows us to add new classes in response to registrations - as certain class levels become full, we can adjust our schedule to offer more classes at that level. New classes start every Saturday, giving parents the ability to take a week off without having to wait 6 weeks to get started again. Hopefully you'll find that our schedule allows you to work around weekends away, without having to "sit out" for 6 weeks.

You may find that the levels & times that you want for your children start on different dates, but you'll generally have no trouble keeping all of your children in the appropriate lesson (in a similar time slot) on a continuing basis.

So, while each child's lesson may have different starting and ending dates, they'll all be able to run continuously at similar times.

You may also find that the level & time you want actually starts before your current class ends.

We aren't trying to make you miss a class - there just happens to be another class offering that overlaps with your current class.

Chances are you'll be able to find the continuation of your current class starting a week or two after your current class.

We do everything we can to offer a logical continuation of each class at the same time the following week.

However, please understand that for every class that ends, there are two candidates for that slot - the same level and the next level up.

We simply have to choose one, and unfortunately there are times when this won't be the perfect choice for you.
